Best practices include getting a bear-resistant trash container, keeping trash indoors, and not putting trash out until Thursday morning. Please read attached flyer for more information.

Please do your part to keep our local bear wild and in the woods and NOT roving the streets of Bayshore looking for a handout on Wednesday or other evenings.
